

ReportPax Labels Questions: Can I Reuse Label Paper or Pick a Starting Position for the Labels?

This comes up when you have printed a set of labels and you have extra blank labels on the page. It would be nice to reuse them. However in my experience I would not recommend it. It's usually more of a hassle than any of the money you save. Plus, the labels don't have to go to waste, they can be used around the office. Lastly, the printer manufacturer's generally don't recommend reusing labels (or paper that has already been printed on).

So with that out of the way, if you really want to try, here is a method that might work. The trick would be to pad your data with blank rows. You could do this using a stored procedure in SQL Server that took the start position as one of it's parameters. Then create a temporary table and loop through and insert as many blank rows as you need. Lastly you would sql union these blank rows with your original label data.

Not the most elegant solution and personally I wouldn't go through the hassle, but it should work.
